ADMINISTRATION

- Absentee ballots are now available for Town Meeting Election of Officers and Referendum
- The compiled town report will be to the printer before the end of this week. The only report we did not receive was from Somerset County.

ANIMAL CONTROL

- \$25.00 per dog late fee has been suspended under executive order.

ASSESSING

- We have made tremendous progress on map/software updates and are working towards rolling out the new online property information database.

CODE ENFORCEMENT & PLANNING

- Waste Management public hearing notices were mailed this week and ads are scheduled for today and next Thursday in the Sentinel.

FINANCE & COLLECTIONS

- 2018 automatic foreclosures: preliminary review indicates that there are 7 properties that were unpaid as of the automatic foreclosure date. We will review each file to ensure proper service and a finalize report will be submitted for Board consideration in the near future.

PUBLIC SAFETY

- Firefighters are expected to receive their first COVID vaccination on Saturday.
- The Department has developed its first grant application under the new consulting agreement. The application will be for SCBA equipment.
- The Sheriff has reached out regarding a law enforcement presence in the future. He inquired as to whether or not the Board would be more interested in such a proposal if he was able to secure a DOJ grant (law enforcement equivalent of SAFER, with phased in costs)
