Mr. LaBelle noted that the intent of the policy is for members to share information during public meetings, so that information can be reviewed in an evidence-like manner.

Mr. Lyman made a MOTION to add *Discussion/Action on Signing of Quit Claim Deed* to the agenda. Seconded by Ms. Lynch. MOTION PASSED.

Ms. Lynch made a MOTION to sign the quitclaim deed releasing the Town's interest in property located at 17 Wade Street and identified on Town tax maps as Map 028, Lot 037 to Blue Birch Properties, LLC, the owner from whom the property was taken. Seconded by Mr. Lyman. MOTION PASSED.

Ms. Curtis made a MOTION to add *Discussion/Action on Fire Department Spending Authorization* to the agenda. Seconded by Ms. Lynch. MOTION PASSED.

Ms. Lynch made a MOTION to authorize an expense of up to \$20,000.00 to purchase and install a new boiler at the fire department. Seconded by Ms. Curtis. MOTION PASSED.

Mr. Lyman thanked members of the board for the cooperation and productivity over the course of his service. Mr. Lyman also noted that the people of Norridgewock are appreciative of mindful

budgeting, which results in a fair, stable tax rate. Stability, both short-term and long-term, is important. As the community grows, Mr. Lyman cautions that investments should be sustainable. He extended appreciation to the Town Manager and Chair for their work and looks forward to his continued service within the community.
