6. Discussion/Action on June 21, 2023 General Warrant

There was a discussion regarding the Town contributing to the Winslow Community Cupboard, as that organization has been serving the community as a mobile food pantry. Members expressed initial support for financially supporting the organization, but question the needs of the organization. The Board discussed an email received from Upper Main Street resident Bob Pomelow regarding the application of herbicidal treatments in proximity to his property. Mr. Pomelow believes that approximately four to six years ago, the herbicidal treatment was the cause of his honeybees dying.

Mr. LaBelle stated that upon receiving Mr. Pomelow's email, he contacted the Acting Director of the State Board of Pesticides Control, who then consulted with the State Apiarist. Feedback from the State agencies was that there was no statutory setback distance for spraying and that glyphosate has no significant impacts on hives. It was noted that hives are usually impacted more significantly by the application of insecticides and/or pesticides, not herbicides. The Board was also presented with a glyphosate fact sheet, as provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

After significant discussion, the Board declined to take any action on Mr. Pomelow's request.
